■ CARILLON ELECTRIC ORCHESTRA CONCERTS

Tuesday, 03 Aug at 18:00, 20:00

Gdańsk is Poland's only city to have a unique mobile carillon. Mounted on the platform of a vintage truck, this instrument consists of 48 bells with a total weight of almost 5 tonnes (the heaviest at 845kg, the lightest at 9kg). How do you play it? A carillonist uses their fists to strike wooden pegs which are laid out like piano keys and are connected with the hearts of immobile bells. Apart from being played by hand, a carillon is also equipped with a foot pedal, somewhat similar to those found in organs. It is a tradition of the Fair to hold concerts which combine the carillon with other instruments.

The gate is equipped with a mechanism to count the people passing through it and with a display to show the current result.

FOR THRILL SEEKERS

- **GDAŃSK CAROUSEL / Targ Rybny (Fish Market)**
Time passes in retro style here :)
The carousel is gorgeous! With two levels, it is 11.5m in height, 12m in diameter and can spin 78 riders at a single time. It was made especially for Gdańsk, based on a Venetian carousel, at a family-owned Italian manufactory. As per tradition, it is decorated with colourful, hand-painted sculptures. All the figures are mobile: they gallop, sway and spin to the rhythm of carousel music. The chariots are disabled accessible. The top of the carousel is decorated with hand-carved ornaments depicting the most important features of Gdańsk's architecture and landscape.

- **AMBERSKY OBSERVATION WHEEL / Ołowianka Island Stop**

- See Gdańsk from a different angle!**

- London has the London Eye, Las Vegas has the High Roller, Singapore has the Singapore Flyer and Gdańsk has AmberSky! Rising 50 meters above sea level, the Observation Wheel is equipped with 36 eight-person, air-conditioned and heated gondolas, including one VIP cabin with a glass floor. The ride takes about 15 minutes. AmberSky is the most thrilling attraction in Gdańsk!
